Description

Elefant is special oil formulated with purpose to remove effectively saccharine and sugar encrustations from machinery and production applications.

Use / application

Apply Nils Elefant with brush or with oiler directly on the incrustations or parts that have to be cleaned, for example on packaging machinery in foodstuff and confectionery industry. Pass the parts or applications to be cleaned directly with cloth soaked in Nils Elefant. After this operation do not pass with dry cloth, in order to leave protective oil film on cleaned applications. Do not use as oil bath. Before the use shake well the holder (even the oiler). Saccharine-solvent oil Nils Elefant does not contain any harmful component. Protect from frost.

This product is acceptable as a lubricant with incidental food contact (H1) for use in and around food processing areas. Such compounds may be used on food processing equipment as a protective anti-rust film, as a release agent on gaskets or seals of tank closures, and as a lubricant for machine parts and equipment in locations in which there is a potential exposure of the lubricated part to food. The amount used should be the minimum required to accomplish the desired technical effect on the equipment. If used as an anti-rust film, the compound must be removed from the equipment surface by washing or wiping, as required to leave the surface effectively free of any substance which could be transferred to food being processed.
